
PARISHIONER SOLICITATION - BASIC FIRST AID, CPR & AED

GENERAL

OLPH possesses an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) device, which is installed in the main floor stairwell. We are seeking individuals who would be comfortable using the AED in an emergency and could apply CPR and basic first aid.

AIM

The aim to establish a list of parishioners who are certified in basic first aid, CPR and the AED. The intent is to have enough certified parishioners available to provide coverage across weekend masses. Quotas have been set for each mass time.

ACCOMPLISHMENT

Parishioners will likely be in one of two groups:

- Group A. Parishioners in this group are already certified because of their employment and/or occupation.
- Group B. These are parishioners we require training to retain their certification if previously trained, and any parishioners who have not had prior training. For those in this group, OLPH has scheduled a one-day training session (8:30 AM to around 4:30 PM) on Saturday, January 27, 2018 in the Parish Hall. The training will be delivered by Canadian First Aid Training. The cost is to be borne by OLPH and lunch will be provided. Up to 20 people can be trained at this session. *(Note: If this date does not work for you register anyway, as we may be able to arrange an alternative training venue.)*
