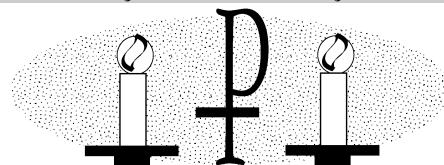

PASTOR'S VIEWPOINT

I was touched and also amused, to learn that many of you had me in your prayer sights as I traveled back and forth from my car escapade and rather enjoyable opportunity to be able to witness and bless my nephew's marriage. Now, all of this is past and old news. This weekend I have to confess about another mini-trip. Friday sees me going West to St. Lazare. I was in that parish from 1970-77. As the world turns, the young boys of ancient years have matured and have brought to this world children of their own. One of them was sent to our parish, OLPH, for marriage preparation. Lo and behold, a request came for me to travel back to my old stomping grounds and to preside, bless their marriage. In a moment of weakness (I have many of those) I accepted. Friday is the rehearsal and Saturday afternoon the wedding. I will drive towards a segment of my past life, wedded to new life, and situated in one very beautiful spot of God's creation where the Qu'Appelle River flows into the Assiniboine. My father once told me that I had been to St. Lazare even before I knew anything about that place. His uncle Albert Comeault worked for Mr. Decorby, who owned a store. My father and mother drove that long strip of highway to visit him. My mother was pregnant with the baby I happened to be. Now that is going back a long time! Since I left St. Lazare, returned a few times for funerals of friends. I have never went back for a wedding.

Some memories fade with old age, but nothing seems to be in the way of helping God create new ones.

Back home at the ranch, we have tried to have a 6:30 p.m. weekday Mass to accommodate the fact that we are now two priests in the parish. The experiment was not all that successful, to put it in a polite way. So, we will turn the page and try something else. We will keep the 6:30 Masses on Tuesday evenings. Morning Mass at 9:00 as always, but mostly concelebrated. Feedback from parishioners is always welcome. The whole experience is a learning curve which is not as easily tackled nor mostly enjoyed as driving at a good clip through one of our Canadian parks sprinkled with lakes and majestic trees. I might not have told you that stopping at a gas station was always a good experience for many reasons, but the most noticeable one would be the hospitality and good nature manifested by clerks of all ages and sizes. No wonder our God is fond of hospitality and identifies Himself with the stranger, the poor, the sick, the 'other' whoever that might be at any given time. Amen.

Pilgrimage to the HOLY LAND

— ‘Walking with Jesus’ November 1-8, 2019 —

Fr. Barry Schoonbaert will be leading a group of pilgrims to the Holy Land with Guide Baligh ‘Billy’ Jazy of Palestine. The 8-day trip will include such places as Nazareth and the Church of the Annunciation, Bethlehem, and the Church of the Nativity, the Church of the Visitation, the Church of John the Baptist, Cana in Galilee, the Pool of Bethesda and church of St. Anne, Capernaum and Peter’s house, the Mt. of Beatitudes, Jericho and the Church of the Good Shepherd, Mt. of Temptation, Jerusalem, the Mt. of Olives, the Garden of Gethsemane, Via Dolorosa, the path of Jesus on the way to Calvary, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher where you find both the place of Crucifixion and the Tomb where Jesus was laid, etc. etc. A complete itinerary is available from Fr. Barry. Mass will be celebrated at one of the Holy Sites each day.

The cost of the tour is \$1675/person double occupancy. Two meals/day, travel coach, hotels, and all entrance fees are included. Airfare will be extra; however, if there is enough interest we are prepared to arrange airfare at a group rate. A \$200 refundable deposit will be required by the end of November 2018 to secure a place on the tour.
